1. <u>CALL TO ORDER</u> – Commissioner Gladhart called the meeting to order at 8:34 a.m.

2. <u>AGENDA</u> – Commissioner Hansen moved, Commissioner Randall seconded, approval of the agenda. <u>Motion approved unanimously.</u>

3. APPROVAL OF MINUTES –

Commissioner Hansen moved, Commissioner Randall seconded, approval of the minutes of October 23rd, 2024, regular meeting. *Motion passed unanimously*

4. <u>PROJECT REPORTS</u> -

4.1 Harbor Hills Antelope North Well Drilling – Andy (WWS) reported that the new well has been capped, and drillers have moved on. Terraphase will analyze results and present a report addressing pump size and well capacity in early December.

Roger (G&O) had presented an updated scope of work for engineering services at the October meeting. Commissioner Hansen moved approval of the Gray and Osborne scope of work G&O #PR235.93 Tasks #1 through Task #4. Commissioner Randall seconded, and the motion passed unanimously.

 - 7.1 REGULATIONS UPDATE Commissioner Randall presented proposed changes to the District's definition of an ADU, changes to the ULID proposal and approval process, and clarification of the District's authority to prohibit new wells in the District's service area. Commissioner Hansen moved with approval of the proposed changes and Commissioner Gladhart seconded the motion. After discussion, the motion passed unanimously.

8.1 Terri (WWS) had previously emailed information related to challenges to the Department of Ecology groundwater policies.

8.2 Terri said there are a number of meters on vacant land that are inaccessible due to blackberries and other barriers. The Board authorized Terri to add \$50 to quarterly invoices if property owners do not comply with District regulations to keep the meter areas clear of vegetation.
